Signs and Symptoms of Exposure

Section VII -- Precautions for Safe Handling and Use

Steps to Be Taken in Case Material is Released or Spilled

If spilled, steps should be taken to prevent discharges to streams or sewer systems. Spilled material should be neutralized with alkaline materials such as soda ash, NOT caustic soda, and absorbed onto inert absorbent, or diluted and sewered.
